## EVENT HEATER COMPARISON - Premier vs. Copy Cats

### L.B. White Offers:

#### Easy Maneuverability and Set Up

- Premier 80 is easy for one person to transport due to small footprint and lightweight design (only 81 lbs.), even up and down stairs
- Premier 170 wheelbarrow style extendable handles, allow adequate space to walk behind heater when moving, and slide into hiding during operation
- Premier 170 rubberized bottom handles are designed to provide perfect, low lifting points, and double as bumpers to protect during transport.
- Wheel placement of Premier 170 at edge provide well balanced movement, and insures no "corner catching" on the floor
- Easy and simple gas connections with wrench free POL

#### Quick Comfort

- Heats area faster due to higher output temperature; Premier 80 produced 159.1° F in a 71.6° F ambient test environment

#### Safety and Trouble-Shooting

- Heaters discontinue operation in unsafe situations such as low air, gas supply, and overheating
- High limit safety switches are protected from dirt and dust to insure proper function
- Outer case stays COOL to the touch during operation
- Quickly get heaters running using the easy to read and understand four stage diagnostic system

#### Heater Fit and Finish

- Smooth burr-free edges eliminates snags and cuts
- Heater cases with excellent water resistance and run-off designed for worry free outdoor use
- Doors are tight and secure, yet offer quick access to both ends of heater for resets or service
- Superior hanger provides space for both gas hose and thermostat when in storage and transport
- Complete troubleshooting guide and wiring diagrams located conveniently inside cabinet
- Long lasting, legible labels made from materials that don't wear, tear, or melt

### Copy Cats:

- Smaller unit is larger, bulkier, heavier - 122 lbs. and thus needs wheels to transport
- Larger unit has limited handles that are close to the unit, causing recurring knee bumps and scrapes.
- Larger unit has limited handles that are placed in a low position on one side only and provide no protection for transport
- Wheels are much closer to center of the unit making balance very difficult when moving, and corners of case often scrape the ground
- Wrench required when tightening to LP gas cylinder, which in turn will wear down the fitting

- Smaller unit produced 152.3° F in a 71.6° F ambient test environment
- Fan continues to operate in the event of burner shut down which circulates cold air into environment (brrrr) and causes extreme stress on motor
- High limit switches are not protected, can allow dirt and dust to enter, potentially causing malfunction
- Outer case gets HOT to the touch during operation (manufacturer acknowledges with warning labels and literature stating "Extremely hot during operation")
- No diagnostic system. If unit fails, lengthy calls must be made
- Overlapping edges snag, while exposed door handle easily breaks and snags as well
- Average water resistance with non-tight openings
- Difficult access to fan and hi-limit reset due to many screws
- Gas hose easily falls off small hanger provided for only gas hose
- Sticker provides (limited) heater specifications only
- Plasticized paper label melts and peels after very limited use
